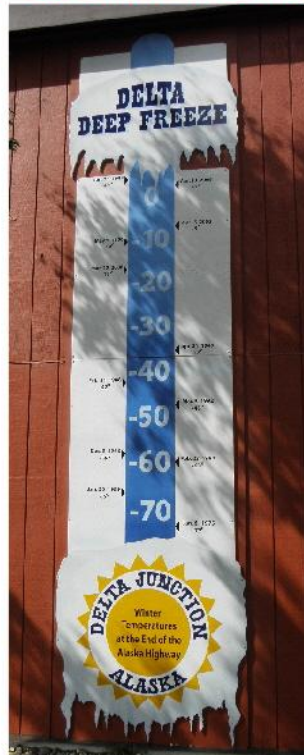
Stop #41 - Smith's Green Acres RV Park, Delta Junction, Alaska

...Delta Junction...the "other" end of the Alaska Highway...



The landmark in Delta Junction [left] looks a lot like the copy in Fairbanks - grin! This IS the original end - Mile 1,422 - to the US Army Corps of Engineers highway. Delta Junction, like many places in the northern human habitat of Alaska, is really cold [center and right]. The record low here is -72°F in January of 1975. I, for one, would not have wanted to go to the outhouse on that morning - grin! We picked up our "official" certificate of completion of driving the Alaska Highway here at the visitor center, but, technically, will not "earn" it until we arrive in Tok today.
